## What is a Fundred?

Each Fundred is an original work of art, hand-drawn on a provided template that is designed to look like US currency. Completed Fundreds are mailed to the Fundred Reserve in Washington DC.

Our goal is to collect millions of Fundreds and engage communities and educate policy-makers in the effort to end lead poisoning. Creating a Fundred is a chance to make your voice heard, while together the Fundreds demonstrate the value we collectively place on healthier communities, poison-free homes, and the imagination of all children.
